The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.02 dated 02.01.2018, registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station S.B.S.Nagar, Ludhiana.

The complainant wanted to go abroad, therefore, he contacted petitioner Karan Oberoi alias Inderpreet Singh, who demanded Rs.11,00,000/- from the complainant. He paid Rs.11,00,000/- to the petitioner for sending him to Canada but the complainant was sent to Russia from where he was deported.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that infact the complainant approached the petitioner for sending him to Canada but at that time, the petitioner told him that he does not send the professionals to abroad rather he is the agent of sending the students abroad on study visa. It is also specifically added in the petition that on the request of complainant, the petitioner introduced him with Sukhwinder Singh Viridi

who settled the matter for a consideration of Rs.6,00,000/-. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that no date of payment is mentioned in the FIR.

Heard.

The petitioner has himself admitted in the petition that there was dealing with Sukhwinder Singh Viridi and the complainant for a sum of Rs.6,00,000/-. Even the petitioner did not disclose the date. Serious allegations have been levelled against the petitioner for duping an amount of Rs.11,00,000/- from the innocent person for sending him to Canada. Rather he sent the complainant to Russia.

To the mind of this Court, no ground is made out to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands dismissed.
