The petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.67 dated 08.05.2014, registered under Sections 452, 323, 427, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Mataur, District SAS Nagar.

It is the allegation against the petitioners that they have trespassed into the property of complainant and caused simple hurt.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Singh, has stated that the petitioners have now joined the investigation; nothing has to be recovered from them and they are no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 20.04.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
