In this petition, the petitioner seeks his release on regular bail in F.I.R. No.347, dated 23.06.2016, under Sections 307, 387 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code read with Sections 25, 54 and 59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

2. The petitioner was arrested on 22.07.2016.

3. There is no direct material against the petitioner apart from the disclosure statement of the principal accused, namely Manesh, who is alleged to have fired at the complainant. The aforesaid assailant Manesh is admittedly in detention.

4. Considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner and the quality of material available against him in the present case, the present

petition is allowed and the petitioner, namely Kismat son of Surat Singh, is directed to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned, with a further direction to report at the concerned Police Station once in a fortnight during pendency of the trial.
