Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners namely Amarjit
Singh and Paramjeet Kaur in case registered by way of FIR No.8 dated
09.02.2018 at Police Station Sanour, District Patiala under Sections 306,
120-B IPC.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sarabjit
Singh from Police Station Sanour, submits that during investigations
both the petitioners have been found innocent. In the light of the same,
present petition has become infructuous and is dismissed as such.

However, it is made clear that in case the petitioners are required subsequently in this case, a clear ten days’ notice be served upon them to enable them to have their legal recourse.
