Above-referred petitions are being disposed of by this common order being connected to each other.

By way of Crl. Misc. No. M-1570 of 2018, petitioners Jaspreet Singh and two others are seeking quashing of FIR No. 81 dated 27.04.2017, registered under Sections 354, 323, 341, 506, 349 IPC at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar, Mohali. Petitioners Harjit Singh and two others had filed Crl. Misc. No. M-1642 of 2018 and are seeking quashing of

cross-version DDR No. 24 dated 29.04.2017, registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 34 IPC, recorded in the aforesaid FIR and consequent proceedings taken therein, on the basis of compromise.

Report has been received from the trial Court after recording statements of the parties on compromise. Trial Court has also sent statements of parties recorded by it, which reveal that compromise is voluntary and without any pressure or coercion.

Learned State counsel submits that the parties in both the petitions are the persons involved in the FIR and cross-version DDR.

No useful purpose would be served to keep the FIR pending.

In view of the statements made by the parties and the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh & Ors. Vs. State of Punjab & Anr. 2007(3) RCR(Crl.) 1052**, approved by Hon'ble the Apex Court in **Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab & Ors. 2012(10) SCC 303**, the instant petitions are allowed and the aforesaid FIR and the cross-version recorded therein and consequent proceedings conducted therein are quashed.

Needless to say that parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise.
