The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.95 dated 21.08.2016, registered at Police Station Ajitwal, District Moga, under Sections 382, 324 and 34 IPC.

Affidavit dated 04.08.2018, has been filed on behalf of the State and the same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner. According to the said affidavit, there are seven other criminal cases pending against the petitioner. All of them pertain either to threat, snatching or dacoity.

In view of the above, the petitioner does not deserve to be granted regular bail as he is likely to indulge in the criminal acts, if he is released on regular bail.

The petition is accordingly dismissed.
