The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.192 dated 15.08.2017, registered under Sections 323, 328, 120-B IPC at Police Station Sadar Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar, Haryana

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is in ninth month of pregnancy. He has further contended that the petitioner is in custody since 06.09.2017 and the co-petitioner Dharminder Singh has already been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 12.02.2018, passed in Criminal Misc.No.M-48072 of 2017.

On the other hand, learned State counsel opposed the instant petition.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the facts that the petitioner is having pregnancy of approximately eight months and that the conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Manisha is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety

bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhari, subject to the following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of her absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel her bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure her presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) She shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
