The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.19 dated 20.01.2018 under Sections 452, 323, 325, 427, 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 19.04.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate so as to get their statements recorded with regard to genuineness of the compromise.

Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tarn Taran has

been received wherein it has been reported that statements of Complainant-Malkiat Kaur as well as of accused Manish Kumar, Paramjeet Kaur, Veeran Sharma and Lalit Kumar, have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that complainant-Malkiat Kaur has no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tarn Taran, that the compromise is genuine and has been effected voluntarily without there being any undue influence, threat or coercion.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.19 dated 20.01.2018 under Sections 452, 323, 325, 427, 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
