Despite giving sufficient time, there is no assistance. On 26.04.2018 following order was passed:

“There is no assistance in the matter. If the appellant failed to apprise this Court whether before writing annual confidential report against the respondent whether concerned authority have complied Rule 14.48 of relevant Rules in respect of writing of Annual Confidential Report be made available on the next date of hearing. Failing which, appeal would be dismissed.”

2. Today, learned counsel for the appellant submitted that from time to time, respondent has been extended the benefits including promotion to the next higher cadre. Therefore, annual confidential report may not come in the way of extending any benefit. Appellants are not in a position to apprise this Court whether respondent name has been overlooked for the purpose of promotion as on 8.10.1998 or not?

3. In view of these facts and circumstances and the fact that there is no assistance on behalf of the appellant, appeal stands dismissed.
