The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case First Information Report No.399 dated 20.11.2017 under Sections 325 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3 of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 registered at Police Station Kasola, District Rewari.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance of order dated 17.01.2018, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

On instructions from ASI Chander Shekhar, the above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State counsel and

stated that the custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, the order dated 17.01.2018 is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.
