Learned counsel for the State makes a statement that respondent No.3-Jai Bhagwan was granted interim bail for a period of 15 days by this Court vide order dated 24.10.2017 and after 15 days, he did not surrender and as such absconded. Now he has been arrested by the C.I.A. Staff and is in District Jail, Kurukshetra. Insofar as respondent No.2-Rahul is concerned, he submits that with reference to the affidavit of Gurmail Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra, both Rahul and his father Jai Bhagwan have left the village along with their family and are living somewhere else.
