Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.2 and 3 for taking appropriate action against respondent No.4 in the context of complaint made by respondent No.5.

Respondent No.5 alleged cheating by respondent No.4. The police could not locate respondent No.4. Petitioner is being harassed only on the ground that he provided visiting cards of respondent No.4 to respondent No.5.

The grievance of the petitioner is that police has started harassing the petitioner without following due procedure of law.

Precisely for the grievance in question, the petitioner has also moved a representation to respondent No.2 on 19.03.2018 but no action has been taken so far.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

In view of nature of order, which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of filing any reply, as no order prejudicial to the interest of either party is being passed.

At this stage, without embarking upon merits of the case, respondent No.2 is directed to look into the grievance of the petitioner and pass appropriate order in accordance with law without being influenced by any statement of fact made hereinabove.
