Of course, if the police itself wishes to submit any supplementary challan pursuant to any orders by a competent police authority, upon a representation made by the petitioner, obviously it would be within its right to do so.

For that purpose, the Inspector General of Police, Border Range, Amritsar (respondent no.3), to whom a representation is stated to have been made by the petitioner, is directed to go into the matter and to take a decision thereon, within a period of 1 month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
