Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to the official respondents No.1 to 3 for taking appropriate action against respondents No.4 to 6 in the context of his representation filed before respondent No.2 on 26.03.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even though formal complaint under Section 154 Cr.P.C. has not been filed before respondent No.3, but respondent No.2 can take cognizance of the controversy where life and personal liberty of the petitioner are at stake.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

In view of nature of order, which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of filing any reply, as no order prejudicial to the interest of either party is being passed.

At this stage, without embarking upon merits of the case, it would be appropriate to ask respondent No.2 to have a fair look on the grievance of the petitioner and pass appropriate order in accordance with law without being influenced by any statement of fact made hereinabove.
