By invoking Section 482 Code of Criminal Procedure (in short, "Cr.P.C."), the petitioner has prayed for quashing of FIR No.35 dated 15.2.2018 for offence punishable under Sections 295, 506 of the Indian Penal Code (in short, "IPC") registered at Police Station Sudhar, District Ludhiana.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Karanbir Singh, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the police has already submitted cancellation report which is pending before learned Magistrate for further orders.

As the cancellation report has been submitted, therefore, this petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed as such. However, a direction

is given to the learned Magistrate to dispose of the cancellation report at the earliest preferably within a period of 60 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
