Petitioners-Puneet Goel, Amit Goel and Anil Goel have filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.292 dated 06.04.2018, registered at Police Station Sector-7, Faridabad, under Sections 506 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

Learned State counsel stated that the FIR has been cancelled.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 20.04.2018, passed by this Court, the petitioners have already joined the investigation. They are not required for custodial interrogation. No useful purpose would be served by sending the petitioners to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 20.04.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute.
