In the instant petition, petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.290 dated 06.04.2018 under Sections 420, 418, 406, 506, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sector-7 Faridabad.

2. Affidavit of Balbir Singh HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Ballabgarh, District Faridabad filed by the State counsel in Court today is taken on record. Learned State counsel on instructions from Davinder Kumar, EOW submitted that petitioner/Puneet Goel and Amit Goel were in custody in case FIR No.289 dated 6.4.2018 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Sector-7, Faridabad and after obtaining permission from the Jurisdictional Magistrate both were stated to have joined investigation on 10.07.2018. They are three petitioners. Whereas one another petitioner namely Anil Goel is concerned, it was submitted that he has not joined the investigation.

3. Accordingly, petitioner-Anil Goel is hereby directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 31.7.2018 at 10.00 a.m.

4. In view of these facts and circumstances, without expressing

any opinion on the merits of the case, order dated 01.06.2018, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioners is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. Respondents were at liberty to make necessary application for cancellation, if any. Similarly, petitioners Puneet Goel and Amit Goel are permitted to withdraw their bail bonds/surety bonds if they desire so, as they are in custody in another case.

5. Petition stands allowed accordingly.
