Petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.05 dated 9.1.2018 under Sections 452, 323, 325, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Mehna, District Moga.

2. This Court vide order dated 19.4.2018 had directed the petitioners to join investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from S.I. Gulzar Singh states that in pursuance to the order dated 19.4.2018, petitioners have joined investigation. That apart observations made by this court in the order dated 19.4.2018 have gone unrebutted.

4. In view of these facts and circumstances, without expressing

any opinion on the merits of case, order dated 19.4.2018, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioners, is hereby made absolute. However, petitioners shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5. Accordingly, the petition stands allowed.
