The petitioner seeks direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to conduct a fair and impartial inquiry in FIR No.99, dated 21.03.2018 registered at Police Station Ferozepur Jhirka, District Mewat, under sections 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC. He further sought transfer of the investigation in this FIR to some other district.

The FIR was registered on 21.03.2018 and the present petition has been filed on 16.04.2018. The police needs to be given breathing time to conduct the investigation. There is nothing on record to suggest that the police is acting in high handed manner.

In view of the above, the present petition is misconceived and is accordingly dismissed. However, the petitioner will be at liberty to file a fresh petition in case subsequent facts and circumstances necessitate the same.
