The MLR has been produced in Court today by learned State counsel and as per it, two of the injuries on the complainant are shown to be bone deep injuries, inflicted with incised weapons and therefore described to be grievous injuries, (though on non-vital parts of the body) as per the FIR.

Though learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the said injuries are not attributed to the petitioner, however, the FIR stating that the petitioner, Sandeep Sandhu @ Pataki, and about 04 to 05 other persons having attacked the complainant, I see no ground to entertain this petition, which is consequently, dismissed.

However, nothing stated hereinabove shall be taken to be an observation of this Court on the merits of the case, for or against the petitioner, but only in the context of this petition seeking anticipatory bail.
