Notice of motion was issued in the case on 20.04.2018 and thereafter, the case has been adjourned on various dates. Even an undertaking was given by the petitioners on 26.07.2018 to pay an amount of ₹5,00,000/- to the complainant on the next date of hearing i.e. 03.08.2018 but no amount was paid on that day. However, two cheques amounting to ₹2,50,000/- each were given to the complainant, which have not been encashed. The intention of the petitioners is not fair as the undertaking given by them has not been fulfilled and the same was made just to get the benefit of interim order.

Keeping in view the allegations levelled as well as conduct of the petitioners in not complying with the order passed on various dates, no ground is made out to grant anticipatory bail and the petition being devoid of any merit is dismissed.
