Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in General Diary No.016 dated 19.12.2017 under Sections 324, 323, 326, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Hathur, District Ludhiana in FIR No.298 dated 19.12.2017 registered under Sections 341, 323, 506 read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station Hathur, District Ludhiana.

While granting interim bail to petitioner No.3, following order was passed on 25.04.2018: -

“Counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, seeks permission to withdraw this petition qua petitioners No.1 and 2 namely Harmanpreet Singh and Manjit Singh.

Ordered accordingly.

Counsel for the petitioner on behalf of petitioner No.3 has

submitted that as per the allegation in the FIR, petitioner No.3 – Beant Kaur along with Harmanpreet Singh and Manjit Singh had given beatings to Jaswant Singh, brother of the complainant.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Hardeep Singh, assisted with counsel for the complainant has submitted that as per the statement of Jaswant Singh recorded under Section 161 Cr.P.C., Harmanpreet Singh has given a rod blow on the back side of Jaswant Singh whereas Manjit Singh has given a rod blow on the eye of Jaswant Singh. It is further submitted that petitioner No.3 – Beant Kaur has given a blow of wooden stick, which hit on the left leg of Jaswant Singh and the petitioner No.3 – Beant Kaur be directed to join the investigation.

List again on 20.08.2018.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Manohar Lal, submits that petitioner No.3 has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to petitioner No.3 vide order dated 25.04.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
