Pursuant to what had been contended before this Court on 27.03.2018 by learned counsel appearing for both, the petitioner as also the complainant, the matter had been compromised between the two, subject to the petitioner paying Rs. 2,50,000/- to the complainant, which it is stated has now been paid, vide a demand draft bearing no. 016334, dated 11.04.2018, a photocopy of which has been produced in Court today.

Learned counsel for the complainant does not deny receipt of the aforesaid demand draft.

Though he submits that the certificates to be distributed to students be released by the investigating officer to the parties concerned, however, this petition being only one seeking anticipatory bail, nothing is stated on merits of the

matter presently.

In view of the compromise arrived at, the order dated 24.01.2018 is made absolute.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
