The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in Compliant case No.RBT-7, titled as “Annu vs. Balla and another” filed under Sections 323, 324, 326, 354-A, 452, 506, 34 of Indian Penal Code and Section 8 of POCSO Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to the order dated 20.04.2018 passed by this court, both the petitioners have surrendered before the trial court and have been released on interim bail, which fact is not disputed by learned State counsel.

In view of the facts that the petitioners have surrendered before the trial court and have been released on interim bail, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order

dated 20.04.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.
