Petitioner has preferred this petition under section 438 Cr.P.C.
as his bail bonds have been cancelled and surety bonds forfeited due to his
absence on number of dates.

Learned counsel submits that the absence was due to reasons
beyond his control. Out of the total amount demanded by the Corporation,
he deposited 50% at the outset. He submits that petitioner shall furnish
undertaking before the court that he shall not remain absent on any date in
future, failing his bail shall stand automatically cancelled.

In view of above, it is directed that petitioner shall appear
before the trial court within ten days and furnish bail bonds and
undertaking, to the satisfaction of the trial court.
