Learned counsel for the petitioner points to the FIR, Annexure P-1, to submit that not even an offer of producing the petitioner before a gazetted officer or Magistrate before his search was conducted, was made to him.

That being so and the quantity of intoxicating powder stated to have been recovered from him being 270 grams, with the commercial quantity being above 250 grams, and as per query from learned State counsel (on instructions to him from HC Saroop Singh), 6 witnesses still remaining to be examined out of 7, I consider it appropriate to admit the petitioner to bail upon his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
