The present petition has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 255 dated 27.11.2017, registered under Sections 323, 325, 452 IPC at Police Station Division No. 2, Police Commissionerate Ludhiana, Punjab.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Sewa Singh submits that pursuant to order dated 20.04.2018, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is cooperating therewith.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that there is a delay in filing of the FIR because parties were exploring the possibility of compromise which ultimately did not mature. He further submits that the petitioner assaulted the complainant at his house late in the night and the same resulted in grievous injury, thus, the petitioner is not entitled to the discretionary relief of anticipatory bail.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation

and is cooperating therewith, no useful purpose would be served by sending him

behind the bars. In view of the same, the petition is allowed and the interim bail order dated 20.04.2018, is hereby made absolute.
