This is the petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in case FIR No.231 dated 30.11.2017 under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471, 120B IPC and Section 201 of the IPC (added vide order dated 04.05.2018) registered at Police Station Sultanwind, Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the complainants have already received the jewelry of their entitlement from the petitioner and they have given affidavits that they do not want to proceed with the case and that this Court had already granted interim bail to the petitioner.

Counsel for the State having been instructed by ASI Ashwani Kumar submits that now the complainant has again approached the police with the plea that the complete quantity of the gold has not been returned by the petitioner.

Since the complainant himself had given an affidavit, therefore, the veracity thereof shall be tested by the trial Court.

In view of the above, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of and the interim bail granted to the petitioner is made absolute.
