Petitioners Kuldeep Singh and Daler Singh have filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0029 dated 11.03.2018, registered at Police Station Kathgarh, District SBS Nagar, under Sections 406 and 420 of Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

The FIR in the present case was got registered by complainant Kulwinder Kaur. As per the allegation in the FIR, main accused Kuldeep Singh, who is the husband of her (complainant) sister-in-law (Nanad) and Daler Singh, who is the real brother of Kuldeep Singh told her husband that they are travelling agents and taken a sum of ₹12 lacs from the complainant for providing a job to her husband after arranging visa to Italy.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 10.07.2018, passed by this Court, the petitioners have already joined the investigation. They are not required for custodial interrogation. No useful purpose would be served by sending the petitioners to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 10.07.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
