Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to the official respondents No.1 and 2 to take appropriate action against private respondents in the context of allegations made by the petitioner in terms of complaints dated 16.10.2017 filed before S.S.P Faridkot and D.G.P. Chandigarh (Punjab).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted initial complaint made on dial No.181 remained unattended by the police and the same prompted the petitioner to file aforesaid complaints before S.S.P Faridkot and D.G.P. Chandigarh (Punjab) subsequently. Learned counsel further submitted that since respondent No.6 claimed himself to be a gun man in CIA

staff, therefore, the petitioner seeks disposal of his complaints by the aforesaid authorities in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Let requisite copies of petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon any reply from respondent/State as no order prejudicial to the interest of the parties is being passed.

At this stage, without meaning anything on merits of the case this petition can be disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to have a fair look on the representation dated 16.10.2017 made by the petitioner and act in accordance with law without being influenced by any statement of facts recorded hereinabove.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
