Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to the official respondents No.1 to 4 in the context of protecting his life and personal liberty from being invaded at the hands of respondents No.5 to 7.

Petitioner claimed himself to be mason who was in business dealings with private respondents No.5 to 7. On receiving the complaint regarding material supplied by the private respondents, he stopped business dealings with respondents No.5 to 7 and that prompted the private respondents to harass and humiliate the petitioner. Petitioner alleged that on 24.09.2017, he was dragged and confined at undisclosed place after giving beatings and snatching of his

motorcycle by the private respondents along with three unknown persons. Complaint made by the petitioner before respondent No.2 is still pending. Initial complaint made to respondent No.3 was not entertained on the ground of jurisdiction of the police station.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Let requisite copies of petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon any reply from respondent/State as no order prejudicial to the interest of the parties is being passed.

At this stage, without meaning anything on merits of the case, this petition can be disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to have a fair look on the representation made by the petitioner and act in accordance with law without being influenced by any statement of facts recorded hereinabove.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
