The present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to provide a copy of FIR, if registered and if the FIR is not registered then respondents No.2 and 3 be directed to register an FIR for stolen a licensed pistol .32 bore bearing No.169101482 of the petitioner.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Counsel for the State, being instructed by ASI Pritam Singh, submits that the petitioner had not approached the police initially. Therefore, there is no question of registering any FIR in the matter. Later on, the petitioner had filed a representation before the police just about 15 days before filing the present petition. A preliminary inquiry was conducted regarding that representation, by joining the Sarpanch of the village and other persons, who were stated to be present at the time of the said marriage. However, the police have found that no such incident, as alleged by the petitioner in the present petition, had happened on that day.

In view of the above, no further orders are required in this case.
