Petitioners seek issuance of necessary directions to the official respondents No.1 to 4 to provide them protection in the context of their lives and personal liberties. Petitioners feel eminent threat at the hands of respondents No.5 to 7.

Respondent No.5 is the husband of petitioner No.1. Respondents No.6 and 7 are brother-in-laws of petitioner No.1. Due to matrimonial discord between petitioner No.1 and respondent No.5, petitioner No.1 left the matrimonial house and started living in her parental house. There was some dispute in parental house as well and thereafter, petitioner No.1 started living in a rented accommodation of which petitioner No.2 is landlord. Petitioners have been threatened and have been given beatings by respondents No.5 to 7 and now they feel reasonable apprehension of being killed by the private

respondents. Petitioners have also filed representation to respondent No.3 on 07.04.2018 for providing necessary protection to them.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. S.P. Singh, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Let requisite copies of petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon any reply from respondent/State as no order prejudicial to the interest of the parties is being passed.

At this stage, without meaning anything on merits of the case this petition can be disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to have a fair look on the representation dated 07.04.2018 made by the petitioner and act in accordance with law without being influenced by any statement of facts recorded hereinabove.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
