Petitioners apprehend threat to their lives and liberty from respondent No. 5 and have, therefore, highlighted this position in their representation dated 17.04.2018 (Annexure P-5) addressed to the Commissioner of Police, District Amritsar-respondent No. 2 and the Station House Officer, Police Station Division-B, District Amritsar-respondent No-respondent No. 4.

Counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Commissioner of Police, District Amritsar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, District Amritsar and the Station House Officer, Police Station Division-B, District Amritsar, respondents No. 2 to 4 respectively, to look into the representation dated 17.04.2018 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners and without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Commissioner of Police, District Amritsar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, District Amritsar and the Station House Officer, Police Station Division-B, District Amritsar, respondents No. 2 to 4 respectively, to look into the representation dated 17.04.2018 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required.
