This is a petition that has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.8 dated 30.01.2017, registered under Sections 366, 376, 511, 34 of Indian Penal Code and Section 8 of POCSO Act, at Police Station Bareta, District Mansa.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State, on instructions from HC Jaswinder Singh, submits that two accused including the present petitioner have been acquitted by the court of Smt. Sukhwinder Kaur, District and Sessions Judge, Mansa on 01.08.2017 and other two accused/juveniles have been acquitted by the court of Smt. Daljit Kaur, JMIC/Juvenile Court, Mansa on 10.07.2017 on the ground that witnesses have turned hostile and hence, the instant petition has been

rendered infructuous.

This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, no further orders are called in the instant petition and the same stands disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
