The petitioner seeks direction to official respondents to consider representation dated 28.09.2017 (Annexure P-4) and to take appropriate action, in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that FIR No.155 dated 24.07.2016 was registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar, under Sections 323, 451, 341, 148 and 149 IPC against the private respondents. Thereafter, the said respondents sat on dharna in front of Police Chowki Apra, District Jalandhar (Rural) and obstructed the traffic causing large scale public inconvenience. In this regard, representation dated 28.09.2017 was made to respondent No.2, to register another FIR for causing public inconvenience/inclusion of the relevant provisions of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, in the existing FIR, but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion.

Mr. A.S. Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4. Let five copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon the private respondents, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider representation dated 28.09.2017 (Annexure P-4) and to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
