This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to further investigate the complaints as detailed in Annexure P/6 by some senior police official seeing the repeated non-action of respondent No.4 into the complaints of the petitioner.

In brief, the case as set out by the petitioner herein is that she was slapped by one Narinder @ Tinku because of a fight between the children of the petitioner and the accused. The matter was reported to the police and a compromise was thereafter effected between the parties. It is further stated that on 12.01.2014 the accused threw some chemical on the body of the petitioner causing injuries to the petitioner.

It is also alleged that on 31.05.2015 the accused persons

entered the house of the petitioner and beat her up and again the matter was reported to the police. However, till date, no action has been taken against the said persons.

Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks action to be taken on the various complaints that have been made by her.

A reply has been filed by way of affidavit of Dr. Richa Agnihotri, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, East, Amritsar who at the very outset submits that the petitioner has not come with clean hands and has concealed and misrepresented the actual facts for taking undue benefits. In the reply, it has been submitted that the allegations as set out were duly investigated by ASI- Gurbaljit Singh from the residents of the area and none of the said inhabitants supported the version as set up by the petitioner. The medical check up of the petitioner was got conducted and the alleged injuries were kept pending for surgical opinion.

In the reply, it is also stated that the allegations of hurling acid on the petitioner by Narinder Kumar and Haldi Ram were also found to be false and frivolous as the eye-witnesses have verified that the petitioner has herself poured some liquid substance with an intention to get them implicated in a false case.

On last date of hearing, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner had contended that all the statements that had been recorded regarding the alleged incident of throwing acid and beating the petitioner were made by residents of Pawan Nagar whereas the incident took place in Dashmesh Nagar.

It is, therefore, by order dated 02.08.2017, this Court had

directed the respondents herein to inform about the distance of Pawan Nagar with the area where the incident took place.

The case is taken up today and there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Pursuant to the said order, a report by way of affidavit of Prabhjot Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, East, Amritsar has been filed stating that the distance of Pawan Nagar with Dashmesh Nagar is hardly 500 meters. In the said affidavit, it is also submitted that an inquiry was conducted by SHO, P.S. Mohkampura and 12 persons have stated that no such incident took place.

I have heard the learned counsel for the respondent and perused the file as well as the additional reply that has been filed.

In view of the above, no orders are called for and hence the present petition is dismissed.
