The petitioner seeks bail under Section 439 read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in FIR No.20 dated 26.02.2015, registered under Section 15 of the NDPS Act, at P.S. Mahilpur.

Heard.

Vide order dated 21.09.2017, passed in CRM-30020-2017 in CRM-M-38203-2016, the petitioner was granted interim bail on medical grounds for a period of three months from the date of his release. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner is a known case of Diabetes Mellitus and Hypertension and is still hospitalized.

Vide order dated 17.01.2018, the State was directed to have instructions with regard to the health of the petitioner. Learned State counsel informs that she does not have instructions in the matter.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is known patient of Diabetes Mellitus and Hypertension and is still hospitalized, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 21.09.2017, passed in CRM-30020-2017 in CRM-M-38203-2016, is extended for another period of three months from today, on his furnishing fresh bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. The petitioner shall surrender back at the jail gate on 24.04.2018, before 5.00 p.m.
