The petitioner seeks protection of his life and liberty at the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5.

Briefly stated the fact of the case are that allegedly there is no criminal case pending against the petitioner but respondents No. 4 and 5 are misusing their position as members of the Punjab Police to illegally harass him. A representation dated 16.02.2018 (Annexure P-1) has been submitted in this regard but no action is being taken thereupon.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Amandeep S. Gill, Sr. DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. Let four copies of petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of order that is being passed there is no necessity to issue notice to private respondents No. 4 and 5 at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No. 3 to objectively consider the representation (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in case the same is necessitated.
