Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C is for issuance of direction to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioners and their family members at the hands of the respondents No.4 to 10.

Reply has been filed by way of an affidavit of Parshotam Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Dera Bassi. As per the reply, while checking was going on at A-1 Hotel by one of the police party regarding the investigation of FIR No.158 dated 28.04.2017 registered under Sections 302, 34 IPC and 25, 27, 54, 59 Arms Act at Police Station Zirakpur, 4 persons have not shown their identity proof to the police. However, on stern questioning, these 4 persons disclosed their names as Vijay Kumar Chabbra, Ashwani Kumar, Ashok Kumar and Vikas Kumar and they were let off thereafter. The petitioners were neither arrested nor detained by the police

at any point of time. Therefore, the allegations that they were tortured, harassed or taken to any police station, is false.

In view of reply so submitted which is based on the affidavit, this Court finds that the prayer of the petitioners no more survives.

Accordingly, present petition is dismissed.
