Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 03.05.2017, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has cooperated.

A compromise has been effected between the parties and copy of the same has been placed on record. A cheque amounting to Rs.2.5 lakhs has been handed over to Narinder Pal Singh, father of the wife. It is stated that the petition for quashing of the FIR shall be filed in the first week of August and subsequently petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act be also filed.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 03.05.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
