Petitioners-Gursangat Singh @ Sangti and Niranjana Singh @
Leela have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal
Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.18 dated
26.01.2018, registered at Police Station Maur, District Bathinda, under
Sections 452, 324, 323, 506, 336, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code and
Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of respondent-
State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as
learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that lalkara is attributed to Niranjana
Singh @ Leela and general allegation of injuries have been levelled against
him. So far as, Gursangat Singh @ Sangti is concerned, he is stated to have
given injury on left ear with kirpan.

Perusal of the record shows that till now, no injury has been declared grievous or dangerous to life though the FIR is of 26.01.2018.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 03.05.2018, passed by this Court, the petitioners have already joined the investigation. They are not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioners to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 03.05.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
