The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.118 dated 15.03.2018 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 341, 506, 427, 379-B IPC (Sections 325, 307 IPC added later on) at Police Station Old Faridabad, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. His name was involved on the basis of statement made by co-accused. Even as per the case of the prosecution, only attribution given to the petitioner is of giving leg and fist blows to one of the witnesses. The petitioner is in custody since 22.03.2018.

Learned counsel for the State, being instructed by ASI Subhash Chand, does not dispute the fact regarding the petitioner being in custody since 22.03.2018 and the attribution qua the petitioner.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon the merits

of the case, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner shall be released on bail pending trial on his furnishing bail bonds/ surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
