This is the second petition filed under Section 439 Cr. P.C., for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.64, dated 27.01.2015, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Nuh District Mewat (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued the case at length but learned State counsel has brought to the notice of this Court that the trial is likely to be concluded as the statements of all prosecution witnesses have been recorded and even the statement of accused under Section 313 Cr. P. C. has been recorded.

Keeping in view the stage of the trial, no ground is made out to release the petitioner on regular bail. The petition is dismissed. However, trial Court is directed to conclude the trial preferably within a period of one month.
