The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.19, dated 23.02.2018, under Sections 323/324/506/379/427/148/149 IPC (Section 326 IPC has been added subsequently), registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar City.

Counsel for the petitioner would contend that it is a case of false implication. It is argued that the present FIR is a counter blast to the previous FIR that had been got lodged 5 months back by brother of the petitioner and in which the complainant herein, namely, Mukesh Kumar was one of the accused. It is urged that in the previous occurrence, brother of the petitioner, namely, Lovepreet Singh had suffered grievous injuries.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner at length, this Court is not inclined to extend in favour of the petitioner concession of pre-arrest bail.

Present FIR has been registered on the statement of Mukesh

Kumar @ Bunty in relation to an occurrence dated 19.02.2018.

Precise allegations are with regard to the present petitioner having armed with a *datar* and inflicted *datar* blows on the head as also left arm of the complainant.

During the course of hearing today, learned State counsel, who is on instructions from HC Hardip Singh has made available for perusal of this Court the medical record. MLR of Mukesh Kumar-complainant and injuries mentioned therein corroborate the version as set up in the FIR.

The specific injuries attributed to the present petitioner has attracted offence under Section 326 IPC.

In view of the serious allegations and gravity of the offence, prayer for anticipatory bail is declined.

Petition is dismissed.
