AJAY KUMAR MITTAL, J. (ORAL)

1. Mr. Kul Bhushan Sharma, Advocate appears on behalf of respondent No.3 and states that Kulbhushan Sharma, proprietor of M/s Greater Ashoka Land and Development Company Private Limited, has since expired who was earlier representing respondent No.3-Private Limited Company.

2. The petitioner has approached this Court, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for directing respondents No.3 and 4 to deliver the possession of plot No.229 measuring 200 mt. sq. yards situated in Ashoka Enclave, Extension No.3, Faridabad; or any other alternative order or direction.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents submit that primary dispute raised in this writ petition is between the petitioner and respondents No.3 and 4 i.e the private parties and is of civil nature for which remedies are before the Civil Court.

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4. After hearing learned counsel for the parties and perusal of the writ petition, we find substance in the arguments raised by learned counsel for the respondents.

5. As notice above, the prayer for directing respondents No.3 and 4 to deliver the possession of Plot No. 229 measuring 200 mt. sq. yards situated in Ashoka Enclave, Extension No.3, Faridabad, indicates that the dispute is between two private persons. Accordingly, we dispose of this writ petition by observing that it shall be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedy either before the Civil Court or any appropriate Forum, in accordance with law.
