AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner absented himself on 11.04.2018 when the case was taken up and, therefore, the bail bonds were cancelled and non-bailable warrants issued.

Counsel submits that because of the petitioner suffering from a psychiatric problem, he could not appear before the Appellate Court on the date fixed. He undertakes that in future the petitioner will, without fail, on each date of hearing, appear before the Appellate Court.

The next date of hearing before the Appellate Court is 07.5.2018.

Petitioner shall appear before the Appellate Court on 25.04.2018 and submit his undertaking to the Court, as has been stated by the counsel for the petitioner.

In case the petitioner appears before the Appellate Court on **25.04.2018** and submits his undertaking before the Court, he shall be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the Appellate Court.

It is made clear that in case the petitioner does not appear before the Appellate Court or does not submit the undertaking to the said

...Court. This order shall be deemed to be non-operative.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
