The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.43 dated 17.03.2017, under Sections 498-A, 323, 406, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sadar Jagadhri.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the direction of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. In fact, the petitioner and respondent No.2 are now residing together, which fact is not disputed by learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2.

Learned State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer

submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation and has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 04.05.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
