KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of the FIR No. 527 dated 16.8.2017 under Section 379-A of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station City Bhiwani, District Bhiwani (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of the compromise (Annexure P-2)..

Heard.

Vide order dated 30.10.2018, both the parties were directed to get their statements recorded before the trial Court and learned Magistrate was directed to submit its report.

Learned District and Sessions Judge, Bhiwani vide its letter dated 3.12.2018 has submitted the report that statements of both the parties have been recorded regarding compromise arrived at between them. They have confirmed the compromise. However, learned District and Sessions Judge, Bhiwani has reported that case is fixed for defence evidence and that the accused apprehends that she may be convicted and for this reason, she has filed the petition. However, the complainant has stated that she has no objection if the proceedings are quashed.

Since the matter has been compromised, present petition is allowed and FIR No. 527 dated 16.8.2017 under Section 379-A of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station City Bhiwani, District Bhiwani (Anneuxre P-1) along with consequential proceedings qua petitioner stands quashed.

Petition stands allowed.
