Prayer in the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been made for grant of regular bail to petitioner Ramesh Kumar in a case arising from FIR No.23 dated 17.01.2017 under Section 346 IPC, later on added Sections 302, 201 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station City Tohana, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that co-accused Kashmiri and Shyam Lal having similar role have been granted bail by the trial Court itself. The petitioner is also entitled for bail treating his case on the same parity as that of his co-accused. The conclusion of trial shall take a long time.

Considering over-all facts and circumstances, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Consequently, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
